

Bedtime is Boring

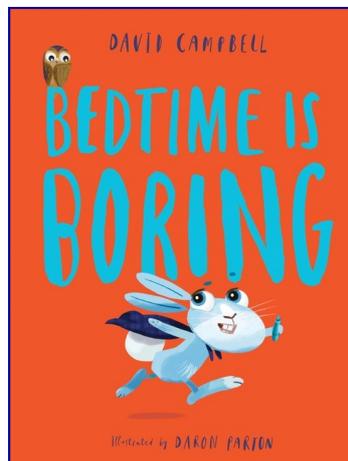

Themes:

Discussion Questions:

- Why did Billy think that bedtime was boring?
- Do you agree with Billy? Or is bedtime a time of day that you look forward to?
- What were the things that Billy wanted to do instead of going to bed?
- Can you recall what time was on the clock when Billy's Dad said it was time to go to bed?
- What did Billy mean when he said that 'the sun is still up...somewhere in the world.'?
- Why is it important to get enough sleep?
- How do you feel the next day if you go to bed late?
- Do you have a bedtime routine? If so, what do you do and in what order do you do it?
- What excuses did Billy use to not go to sleep?
- Do you ever do the same?
- How did Betty feel about going to bed?
- Why do you think they had different attitudes about going to bed?

Activities:

- Design your own cardboard robot, like the one that Billy made.
- Write your own guide to going to bed. This could be a list of the things you do before going to bed, or things that Billy did. Draw some pictures to accompany your bedtime guide!
- Draw your favourite scene from the story.
