

Realising that there are probably others like them out there, they start The Sad Ghost Club and put posters up to encourage others to join. But when a new member wants to join their club, Socks feels like three is a crowd and that they are now the odd one out, and Socks goes home sad.

Can they find a way to welcome a new member to the club and continue to support each other?

But when they arrive at the next advertised meeting of The Sad Ghost Club they don't have to worry about three being a crowd anymore! Because there might be many other sad ghosts who want to join their new club too...
